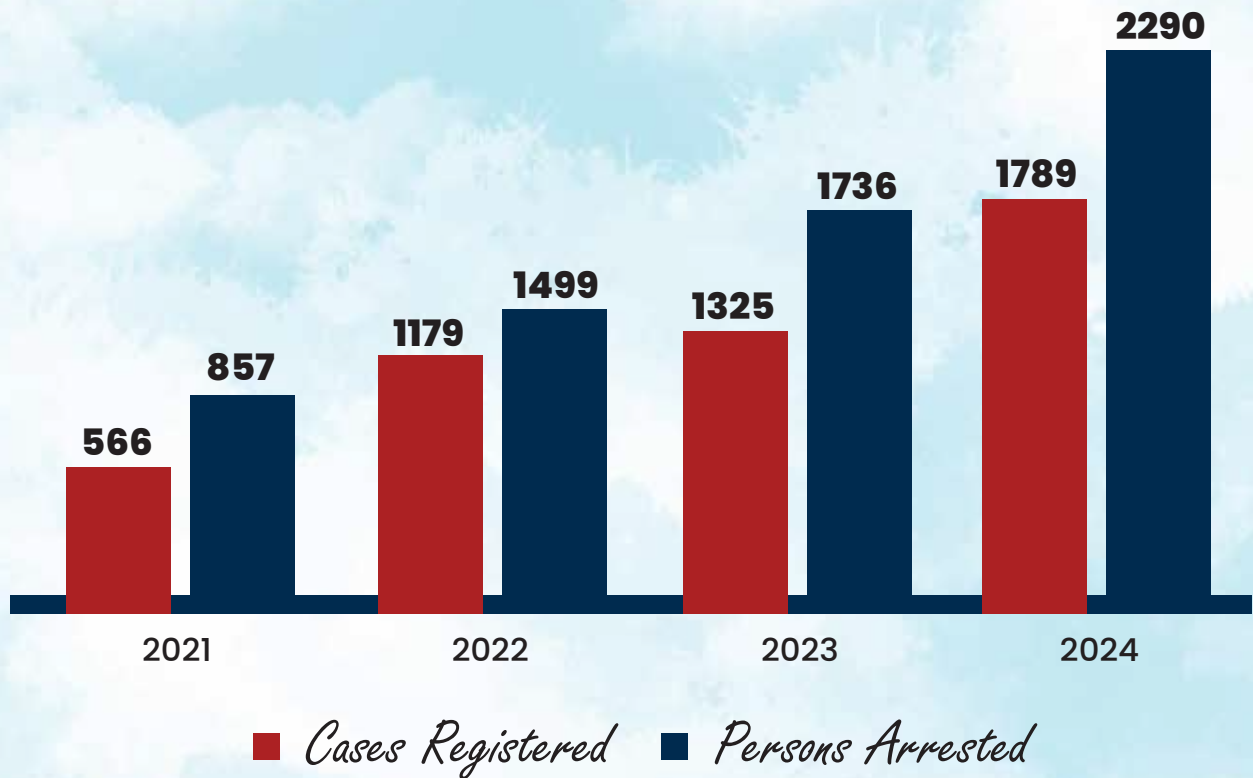

CRACKDOWN ON SUPPLY CHAIN NETWORKS



DRUG DESTRUCTION



As per the Hon'ble Supreme Court's orders, Delhi Police has formed various committees for the disposal of seized drugs under the "**Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan.**" Over the past two years, significant quantities of illegal drugs have been destroyed:

ACTION TAKEN UNDER PITNDPS ACT

In Delhi, detention orders have been issued against a total of 25 drug traffickers under the Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (PITNDPS) Act. These criminals were involved in drug trafficking for years and there after were lodged in various prisons. Additionally, proposals for detention orders against 37 more drug traffickers are under process.
